- iii. Where are the payment certificates for the respective works done in Tuluongoi location, Marigat ward?
- iv. Which officer was in charge of the said works?
- v. Would this be fraudulent agenda to siphon public funds and deny the intended beneficiaries of the much deserved infrastructure?
- vi. What remedy is the department putting in place to ensure that the stated works are timely completed?
