THAT, livestock is a source of livelihood in most parts of Baringo County especially Tiaty, Baringo North, Baringo South and Mogotio Sub-Counties and cognizant of the fact that livestock is a source of revenue to Baringo County Government

AWARE THAT, during the rainy season, outbreak of diseases that include; East Coast Fever, Foot and Mouth, Anthrax and Lumpy skin is widely experienced;

- i. What has the department done to identify the diseases?
- ii. What has the County Government done to make sure that the animals are vaccinated and healthy?
- iii. How much funds has been set aside by the department for the said vaccination?

041/2024 Hon. Julius Ngotie, MCA, Eldama Ravine, seeks statement from the **Chairperson Trade, Tourism and Cooperatives Committee** on the following matters of concern;

THAT, the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides for devolution of Trade and Co-operative societies and that, the County Government of Baringo since the inception of devolution has been budgeting and disbursing loans to Small Medium Enterprises (SMEs).

THAT, article 195(1) of the CoK 2010 as read together with Standing Orders 196(5) gives the County Assembly powers to compel production of documents and any important information.

Pursuant to the above;

- i. What was the initial amount budget for the SMEs
- ii. What amount have been Disbursed and recovered since inception.
- iii. Give the status of repayment/recovery per Sub County.
- iv. Provide the list of non performing accounts, giving the total sum of the loans defaulted.

- v. From the initial amount how much has since been added to the Kitty in the subsequent County budgets?
- vi. Does each Sub County has well updated ledger books? If so please furnish the House with the updated ledger books.
- vii. Can each Sub County operate a separate account for easy follow up?
- viii. Please give details on how the current Kshs.2 million was disbursed as per each Sub County.
- ix. Give the status report of the Baringo County SMEs since inception to date per each Sub County and;
- x. A detailed list of SME loans beneficiaries since inception as per Sub County.
- xi. Provide an updated ledger book for every loanee for the last three year SME disbursements.
- xii. Furnish this House with the latest updated Bank statement.

- i. What measures is the County Government putting in place to facilitate the screening of residents of these areas to avert a looming health crisis as a result of the outbreak of this deadly disease?

- ii. What plans does the department have to facilitate the vaccination process of the residents in these areas against the disease?
- iii. What measures is the County Government taking to initiate the process of sensitizing the residents on the symptoms, causes and treatment of Hepatitis B?

(The answer was not satisfactory. The committee should take note of the statistics and clarify the distribution of results for Tiaty East and Tiaty West)
